The purpose of this lesson is to evaluate the kind of lifestyle a person wants and to align job seeking plans with this type of personal expectation. The online resource Reality Check is an eye-opening beginning to setting realistic expectations.

- 2. Share the "I can" statements and post within the room for reference. (above)

You may wish to share the steps below in printed format with job seekers, as you walk them through the following:

- 3. Turn on computer and log on to network, if not already accessed.
- 4. Go to https://nccareers.org/realitycheck/#/start
- 8. Click "get started" and answer the series of questions.
- 9. When you see your monthly budget report, click on the three lines in the box over the pie chart to print your report.
- 10. After accessing your report from the printer, put your name and monthly salary needs on the print out.
- 11. You may repeat the process multiple times, adjusting your expectations, or the amounts you allot for activities/needs.
- 12. After you have completed the survey and printed your results, we will share our findings through a group game.

13. Teacher directions for group discussion:

Ask the class:

"Will everyone whose monthly needs fall between \$1000-3000 please stand in the front corner; if your monthly income needs fall between \$3000-\$5000, please stand in the front far corner; if your monthly incomes needs fall between \$5000-\$7000, please stand in the back corner; if your monthly income needs fall between \$7000 and above, please stand in the fall back corner."

At this time, instruct your students to talk with the people in their group about what expense most surprised you and why.

- 14. Reflect on the "I can" statements, asking learners to give a "thumbs up" or "thumbs down" if they feel the objective was met.
- 15. Next Steps: Job Seekers can speak more with counselors about their findings and/or research careers based on findings.
