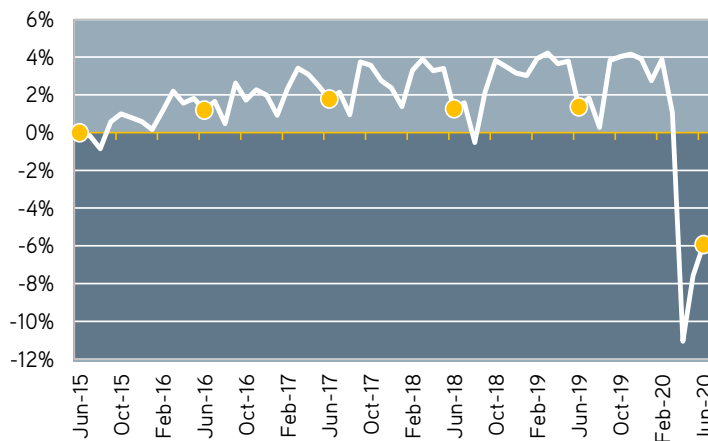

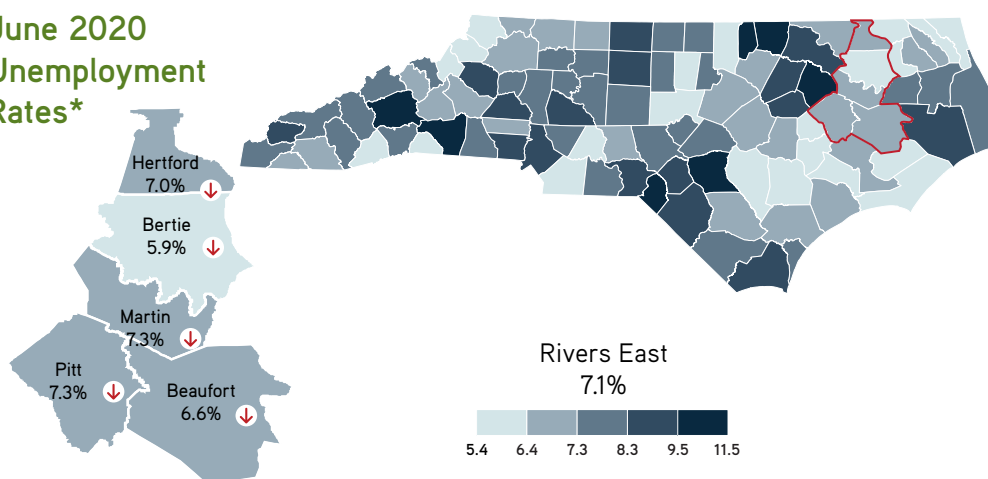
Change in Employment since 2015*
