# What is WIOA?

- WIOA stands for Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act
- WIOA is a national employment and training program designed to strengthen and improve the nation's workforce
- The goal of all (4) WIOA programs is meeting your **employment** and **training** goals through career and training services



# Who can benefit from WIOA Services?

Individualized WIOA career & training services are offered to customers who are in need of additional resources to obtain and/or retain employment that allows for self sufficiency.

- Eligible customers who are in need of skills for entering or re-entering the workforce
- Eligible customers who are unable to obtain or maintain full-time employment
- Eligible customers who are underemployed



# General Eligibility Requirements

- Be a US Citizen or eligible non-citizen authorized to work in the United States
- Be 18 years or older (Adult Program)
- Be a resident of the Rivers East region (Beaufort, Bertie, Hertford, Martin, & Pitt counties)
- Be willing and able to enter full time employment
- Be registered for the US Selective Service (males born after December 31, 1959 only)

# Training Services

- To be eligible for training assistance in the classroom or on-the-job, you must also qualify based on:
  - Household Income & Family Size
  - Receipt of Public Assistance
  - Dislocated from your previous job
  - Long term unemployed

# To be successful you must..

- Be responsive to and communicate with your Career Advisor.  
You are required to make contact with your Career Advisor at least once per month.
- Submit verification documentation when requested
- Remember that the end goal is employment
- Put in the work..we can't do it for you!
