SUBJECT: Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) Co-enrollment

PURPOSE: To establish a policy in which any TAA certified worker will be co-enrolled into the Dislocated Worker (DW) program. Once co-enrolled, the service provider will follow all other applicable policies in serving the individuals, enrolled in Title I services.

ACTION: WIOA Service Providers must review and implement the attached policy.

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As indicated in 20 CFR 618.605, TAA will now be a mandatory partner in the NCWorks Career Centers. All individuals participating in TAA will be co-enrolled as WIOA Dislocated Workers if the worker is eligible.

TAA forms should continue to be utilized as the primary documentation to avoid duplication of efforts. In addition, the dislocated worker's assessment (20 CFR 618-345), or the individual employment plan outlines the assessment results, employment and occupation/training goals must also be scanned into NCWorks. To the extent possible, WIOA and TAA staff should work together to share common forms for services such as attendance and travel reimbursement.

Service providers should ensure they follow all other applicable Local Area policies in regards to serving dislocated workers.
